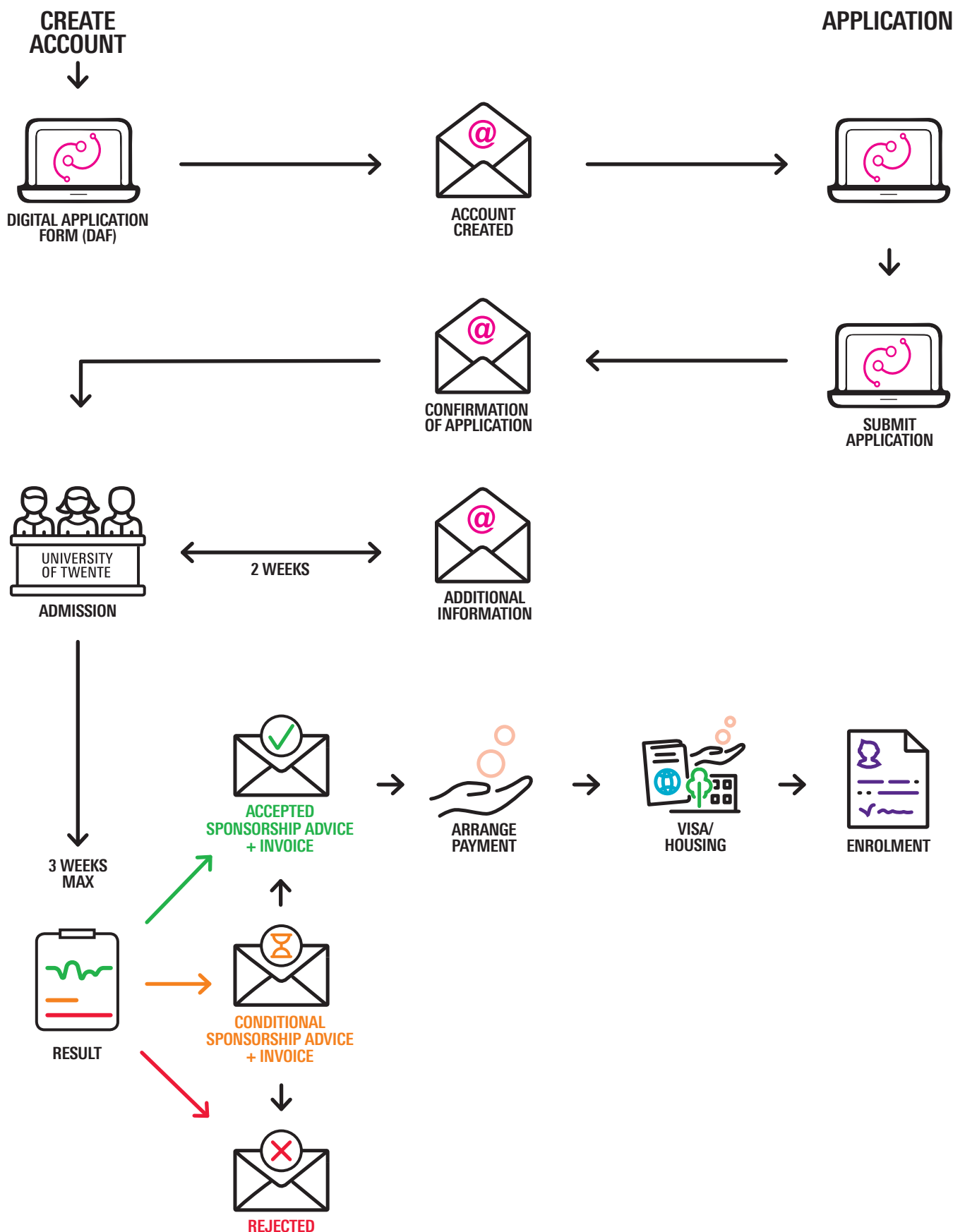

CREATE PROFILE

Select a course in the Study finder, open the course description by clicking on the course title, use the "Go to registration" button at the top of the page. This will take you to the ITC online course application system (DAF). You will first need to create an 'account' using your email and a password. You will then receive an email to confirm your account. This can take some minutes. Click on the link in the email to confirm your account.

APPLY AND SUBMIT

Once the account is created you can make online applications for various courses at ITC through DAF. In your account select the course for which you wish to apply or again use the Study finder. Check your eligibility. If you are or appear to be eligible, please complete the online form and submit your application.

CONFIRMATION OF APPLICATION

Immediately following your application, you will receive a confirmation by email so you know your application has been received. If you are still required to submit documents, you will receive additional instructions via email and the message box in your DAF account about what you need to do to complete your application.



ADMISSION

We first check whether we have all the information we need to assess your application. We will then determine whether you can be admitted to the course. Once you have submitted all relevant details, the admissions committee will assess your application. You will be notified of your admission decision within three weeks.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

If we require further information from you during the application process, we will of course let you know! If you receive no further communication from us, this means we have all the information we need to assess your application.



ACCEPTED

You will be sent an email with a provisional admittance letter. You can also download your provisional admittance letter, your invoice for the course fees, health insurance premium and living expenses from your DAF account. You will also receive information about scholarships.



CONDITIONAL

You do not meet the entry criteria yet and you have been accepted pending your graduation. You will be offered conditional admission through email. You can also download your conditional admittance offer, your invoice for the course fees, health insurance premium and living expenses from your DAF account. You will also receive information about scholarships.



REJECTED

In some cases you may not meet the admission requirements for the course of your choice and your application will be rejected. This will be explained in the e-mail through the message box in your DAF account.



ARRANGE PAYMENT

The invoice must be paid at least three months before the starting date of the course to cover the total duration of the cost. Applicants for the MSc, Postgraduate and Diploma programme can pay their tuition expenses in two installment periods.

For certificate courses with a duration of 12 weeks or less the invoice must be paid at least six weeks before the starting date of the course.

For online courses the invoice must be paid at least four weeks before the starting date of the course.



VISA / HOUSING

We arrange visa and residence permit for non-EU students. The visa application process will be started after we have received your payment or statement of your scholarship provider.



ENROLMENT

When your invoice has been paid and you have submitted all necessary documents, a final check will be carried out. Once everything has been approved, we will enrol you for your study programme. If we have further questions, we will get in touch with you. Make sure to keep a close eye on your mailbox. You will receive information to prepare yourself for your studies.
